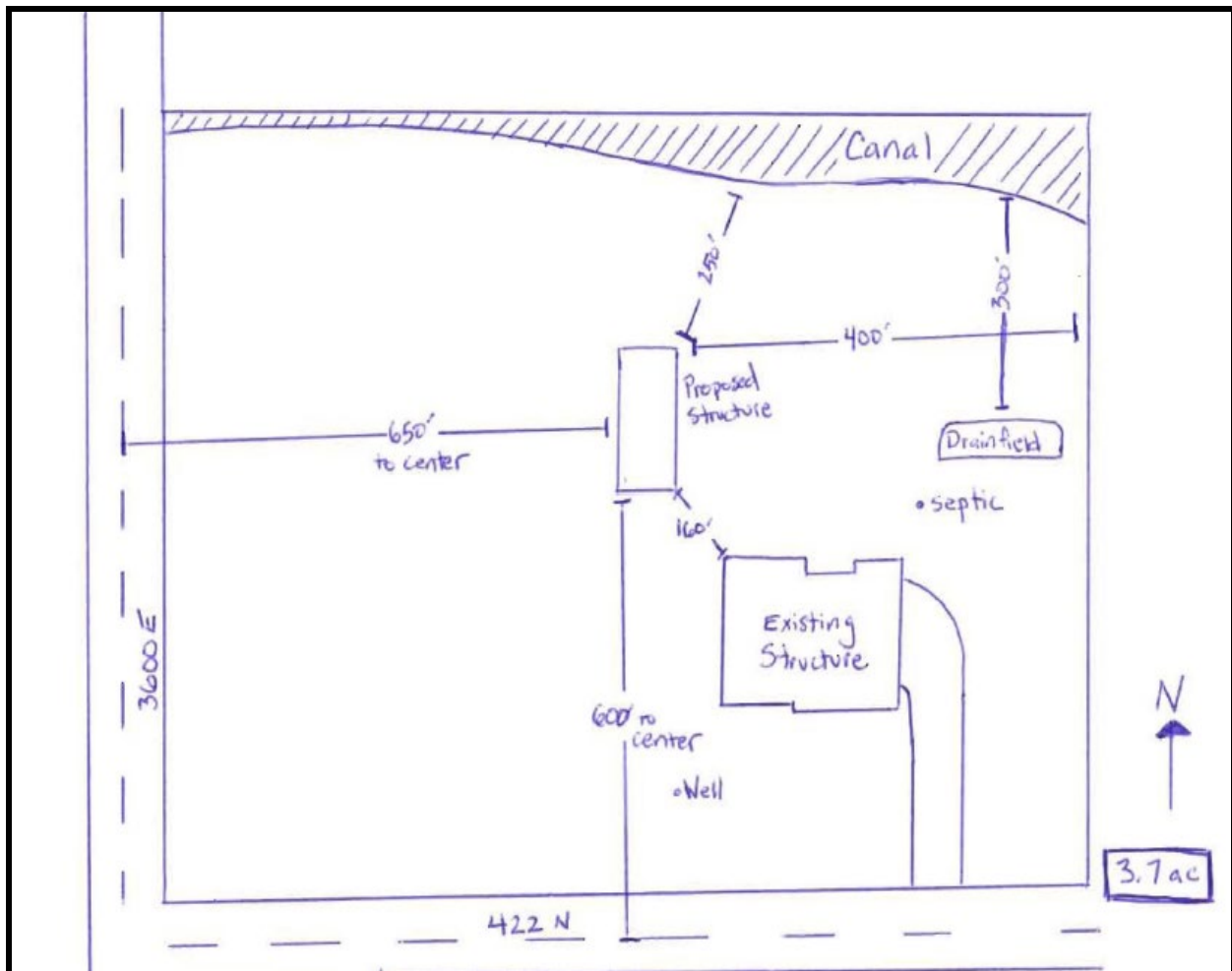
Demolition Permit Checklist

All items on this checklist must be presented before any permit application will be accepted.

The following items are needed to apply for a demolition permit:

- Recorded Warranty Deed
- Site plan showing structure being demolished, other structures on property, setbacks, well, septic, property lines, driveway, power lines, canals, etc.
- Report from a Certified Asbestos Inspection Company (see attached list of State of Idaho Department of environmental Quality Certified Asbestos Inspection Companies) that asbestos is not present.
- If Asbestos is present you are required to submit an ASBESTOS 10-DAY RENOVATION/DEMOLITION NOTIFICATION FORM to Idaho DEQ. You must also submit a copy of the form to Jefferson County Planning, Zoning & Building Department.
- Written Statement from Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) of what steps must be taken for asbestos abatement.
- A plan showing the dates and time frame of when the structure will be demolished and a dust mitigation plan.
- Proper Fee from Fee Schedule.
